## **Recent Grant Application Brings Out The Best In The Shires Community**

One complaint

One thing you should know about your neighbors who live in Shires Housing is that they are proud members of the Bennington community. They are the hard-working people that do essential work and provide valuable services that make our town what it is.

This is especially important to note during the recent controversy over the new Shires Housing development

to be created on Silver Street.

At issue was whether or not the town should accept a

grant on behalf of Shires Housing to help build a 5.5 million dollar development for additional housing that fits the budgets of working people in Bennington.

At times the discussion on this issue became very heated. Some very distressing

things were said about "the type of people" that live in Shires Housing.

We want to be very clear, that the "type of people" in Shires Housing are THE SAME type of people found throughout Bennington. We are all members of the same community, with the same hopes and fears, with the same goals of improving our lives as everyone else.

And yet when the negative statements were at their worst, Shires Housing residents were at their best. When accusations of criminality, drug use, and worse were being thrown around the room, members of the Shires Community sat calmly and respectfully. They quietly but firmly showed

their support, meeting after meeting. Elderly and disabled residents came despite physical hardship. Workers with families found the time to come out. Supporters and members of the business community risked losing customers to speak in favor of Shires Housing and to remind the community of over two decades of good work this organization has done for residents of this community.

Much also was said about the use of our tax dollars. To be very, very clear: not one dollar of local tax money will be used to fund this project. The ONLY tax dollars used are taxes that have been specifically allocated for this purpose from the State and Federal government.

The fact that Shires Housing is being successful bringing these tax dollars BACK into your community instead

of them going elsewhere should be something we applaud, not complain about.

We also heard the very odd issue that the housing proposal costs TOO much. That private landlords could build housing for much less. Well, it may be true that others can build units for less, but the old adage "you get what you pay for" still rings true. The fact is that Shires Housing builds top quality housing that you can be proud to live in, or next to.

So we sincerely thank YOU, the Shires Housing community, for being the heart and soul of our community, and for your proud belief that we all deserve a great place to live, at a price you can afford.

## Don't Be Surprised By New VT Laws

Here is a heads up... two recently enacted Vermont State Laws can catch you by surprise! So take note of these new laws so you will not have an unpleasant surprise if you are pulled over:

#### Cell Phones In Cars

As of October 1, handheld cell phone use is no longer allowed while driving. Police are now authorized to pull over drivers who are seen using a cell phone.

#### Smoking In Cars with Children

It is now illegal to smoke in a car with a child present who is under the age of eight years old.

All regular maintenance

that is considered "wear and tear" is done for free, so don't hesitate to call us. Other needed repairs (hey, accidents happen!) are done at below market rates by our dedicated maintenance staff. If you have a general maintenance request, please call Shires Housing at (802) 442-8139 ext. 4 and follow the directions. This will lead you to the designated maintenance voicemail, and your work request will be added to the next time the crew is in your area.

#### Report Water!

If you ever notice water leaks in your apartment, or in any common areas, please contact us immediately! Water leaks can cause a lot of damage and wasting water is a major environmental problem.

## Report any maintenance When is Maintenance An Emergency? Good question. Fire, no heat,

hot water is cold, fire alarm, sewer backup, sink or tub fully clogged, water leak that a bucket cannot contain, toilet is plugged after using a plunger,

or being locked out of your apartment are all emergencies. If you have any of these issues Call the Shires office (802) 442-8139, Ext 7 and follow the directions which will activate the on-call paging system and get you an immediate response.

One thing that is NOT an emergency is Comcast needing to get in the basement. Make sure to contact the office during regular business hours to schedule a Comcast installation that requires basement access.

#### **Don't Worry About Inspections**

Our goal is to make sure your housing is in tip-top shape, not to judge your decorating choices. Any problems or issues we find we will fix so you can have maximum enjoyment of your housing!

## Fall Reminders

## Avoid the Snowplow!

## **Put Away Outside Toys** and Furniture

All outside toys, furniture etc. need to be stored by November 1st. This is very important to make sure that your property is not destroyed by the weather or hidden by snow and crushed by the snowplow!

## Save the **Environment!**

#### **Remove Air Conditioners**

Air conditioners must be removed by November 1st.

#### **Close Windows**

All windows must remain closed after November 1st when your heat is on.

#### Don't Leave Water Running

While leaving water running may be amusing to your pets, it is a terrible waste of water and not allowed in Shires Housing.
